# Chapter 1: Certain Infectious and parasitic diseases (A00-B99)

- New sub-chapter: Infections with a predominantly sexual mode of transmission (A50-A64)
- You will not find:
  - “septicemia” - rather, it has been replaced with “SEPSIS” in chapter 1
  - Streptococcal sore throat – this has been reclassified to Diseases of the Respiratory System

# Guidelines

- Use additional code for any associated drug resistance (Z16)
- At B39: use additional code for any associated manifestation
- The National Center for Health Statistics has published guidelines for
  - HIV
  - Infectious agents as the cause of diseases classified to other chapters
  - Infection resistance to antibiotics
  - Sepsis, Severe Sepsis, and Septic shock

# Chapter 2: Neoplasms (C00-D48)

- A change in the order of the conditions
  - ‘in situ’ neoplasms will be located before the listing of benign neoplasms
- You will not find:
  - “without mention of remission” for multiple myeloma, malignant plasma cell neoplasms and leukemia – but rather: “not in remission”
- Extranodal and solid organs sites not merit a separate fifth character
  - In ICD-9-CM these were included in 5<sup>th</sup> digit selections for Hodgkin’s disease, non-Hodgkin’s lymphoma, peripheral and cutaneous T-cell lymphomas

C00-C75	Malignant neoplasms, stated or presumed to be primary, of specified sites, except of lymphoid, hematopoietic and related tissue
C00-C14	Malignant neoplasms of lip, oral cavity and pharynx
C15-C26	Malignant neoplasms of digestive organs
C30-C39	Malignant neoplasms of respiratory and intrathoracic organs
C40-C41	Malignant neoplasms of bone and articular cartilage
C43-C44	Malignant neoplasms of skin
C45-C49	Malignant neoplasms of mesothelial and soft tissue

- Use an additional code to identify
  - Alcohol abuse and dependence
  - Alcohol dependence in remission
  - Tobacco dependence
  - History of tobacco use

# Chapter 3: Diseases of the blood and blood-forming organs and certain behaviors involving the immune mechanism (D50-D89)

- Conditions now categorized clearly in sub-chapters
- Terminology updates for today's lingo
- You will find greater specificity than ICD-9-CM
  - Conditions that were clumped into NOS codes now have their own code assignment

D50-D53      Nutritional anemias

D55-D59      Hemolytic anemias

D60-D64      Aplastic and other anemias and other bone marrow failure syndromes

D65-D69      Coagulation defects, purpura and other hemorrhagic conditions

D70-D77      Other disorders of blood and blood-forming organs

D78      Intraoperative and postprocedural complications of spleen

D80-D89      Certain disorders involving the immune mechanism

  - Poisoning by
  - Adverse effects of
  - Under dosing of drugs, medicaments and biological substances to identify the drug
- Notes to “code also”
  - The underlying neoplasm
- No Specific Official Guidelines at this time for this chapter

# Chapter 4: Endocrine, nutritional and metabolic diseases (E00-E90)

- Many new subchapters
  - Of special note: Diabetes Mellitus (DM) has its own subchapter
    - Five separate categories for DM
  - You will not find:
    - ‘controlled’ or ‘uncontrolled’ for making the code selection for DM
- Many new code titles

E00-E07 Disorders of thyroid gland

E08-E13 Diabetes mellitus

E15-E16 Other disorders of glucose regulation and pancreatic internal secretion

E20-E35 Disorders of other endocrine glands

E36 Intraoperative complications of endocrine system

E40-E46 Malnutrition

E50-E64 Other nutritional deficiencies

E65-E68 Overweight, obesity and other hyperalimentation

E70-E88 Metabolic disorders

E89 Postprocedural endocrine and metabolic complications and disorders, not elsewhere classified

- You will not find groupings by
  - Psychotic
  - Nonpsychotic
  - Mental retardation
  - Continuous / episodic for substance abuse

F01-F09 Mental disorders due to known physiological conditions

F10-F19 Mental and behavioral disorders due to psychoactive substance use

F20-F29 Schizophrenia, schizotypal and delusional, and other non-mood psychotic disorders

F30-F39 Mood [affective] disorders

F40-F48 Anxiety, dissociative, stress-related, somatoform and other nonpsychotic mental disorders

F50-F59 Behavioral syndromes associated with physiological disturbances and physical factors

F60-F69 Disorders of adult personality and behavior

F70-F79 Mental retardation

F80-F89 Pervasive and specific developmental disorders

F90-F98 Behavioral and emotional disorders with onset usually occurring in childhood and adolescence

F99 Unspecified mental disorder

  - Mental disorders due to known physiological conditions :
    - Code first underlying physiological condition

# Chapter 6: Diseases of the nervous system (G00-G99)

- Includes only the nervous system
- You will not find here:
  - Sense organs have their own chapters
    - Eye/adnexa
    - Ear/mastoid processes

G00-G09 Inflammatory diseases of the central nervous system

G10-G13 Systemic atrophies primarily affecting the central nervous system

G20-G26 Extrapyramidal and movement disorders

G30-G32 Other degenerative diseases of the nervous system

G35-G37 Demyelinating diseases of the central nervous system

G40-G47 Episodic and paroxysmal disorders

G50-G59 Nerve, nerve root and plexus disorders

G60-G64 Polyneuropathies and other disorders of the peripheral nervous system

G70-G73 Diseases of myoneural junction and muscle

G80-G83 Cerebral palsy and other paralytic syndromes

G89-G99 Other disorders of the nervous system

H00-H05	Disorders of eyelid, lacrimal system and orbit
H10-H11	Disorders of conjunctiva
H15-H21	Disorders of sclera, cornea, iris and ciliary body
H25-H28	Disorders of lens
H30-H36	Disorders of choroid and retina
H40-H42	Glaucoma
H43-H44	Disorders of vitreous body and globe
H46-H47	Disorders of optic nerve and visual pathways
H49-H52	Disorders of ocular muscles, binocular movement, accommodation and refraction
H53-H54	Visual disturbances and blindness
H55-H57	Other disorders of eye and adnexa
H59	Intraoperative and postprocedural complications and disorders of eye and adnexa, not elsewhere classified
