# Chapter 15 Pregnancy, childbirth and the puerperium (O00-O9A)

- Similar to organization of ICD-9-CM
- ICD-9-CM requires episode of care information
- ICD-10-CM requires the trimester in order to assign a code

# Notes

- 1<sup>st</sup> trimester – less than 14 weeks 0 days
- 2<sup>nd</sup> trimester – 14 weeks 0 days to less than 28 weeks 0 days
- 3<sup>rd</sup> trimester – 28 weeks 0 days until delivery

- 000-008 Pregnancy with abortive outcome
- 009 Supervision of high risk pregnancy
- 010-016 Edema, proteinuria and hypertensive disorders in pregnancy, childbirth and the puerperium
- 020-029 Other maternal disorders predominantly related to pregnancy
- 030-048 Maternal care related to the fetus and amniotic cavity and possible delivery problems
- 060-077 Complications of labor and delivery
- 080, 082 Encounter for delivery
- 085-092 Complications predominantly related to the puerperium
- 094-09A Other obstetric conditions, not elsewhere classified
- [Note: 09A is not an error, it is a special subsection for "*Maternal malignant neoplasms, traumatic injuries and abuse, classifiable elsewhere but complicating pregnancy, childbirth and the puerperium*"]

## Chapter 16 Certain conditions originating in the perinatal period (P00-P96)

- Terminology updated
- A few new subchapters
- Term “fetus” no longer part of some descriptions
- The subclassification of 2500 grams and over for birthweight is no longer an option

# Notes

- Codes are only for use with the newborn or infant record – never on the maternal record
- Codes are for liveborn infants
- If condition originates in the perinatal period and continue throughout the lifetime the perinatal code should continue to be used regardless of age

- P05-P08 Disorders related to length of gestation and fetal growth
- P09 Abnormal findings on neonatal screening

- P19-P29 Respiratory and cardiovascular disorders specific to the perinatal period
- P35-P39 Infections specific to the perinatal period
- P50-P61 Hemorrhagic and hematological disorders of newborn
- P70-P74 Transitory endocrine and metabolic disorders specific to newborn
- P76-P78 Digestive system disorders of newborn
- P80-P83 Conditions involving the integument and temperature regulation of newborn
- P84 Other problems with newborn
- P90-P96 Other disorders originating in the perinatal period

## Chapter 17 Congenital malformations, deformations and chromosomal abnormalities (Q00-Q99)

- Subchapters and blocks makes it easier to identify conditions
- Updated terminology
- Greater specificity

# Notes

- Instructional notes to use additional code for associated glaucoma are found in the codes for congenital malformation of the anterior segment of the eye
- Congenital anomalies or syndromes may occur as a set of symptoms or multiple malformations that may each be assigned a code if there is no one specific code for the anomaly

- Q00-Q07 Congenital malformations of the nervous system
- Q10-Q18 Congenital malformations of eye, ear, face and neck
- Q20-Q28 Congenital malformations of the circulatory system
- Q30-Q34 Congenital malformations of the respiratory system
- Q35-Q37 Cleft lip and cleft palate
- Q38-Q45 Other congenital malformations of the digestive system
- Q50-Q56 Congenital malformations of genital organs
- Q60-Q64 Congenital malformations of the urinary system
- Q65-Q79 Congenital malformations and deformations of the musculoskeletal system
- Q80-Q89 Other congenital malformations
- Q90-Q99 Chromosomal abnormalities, not elsewhere classified

# Chapter 18 Symptoms, signs and abnormal clinical and laboratory findings, not elsewhere classified (R00-R99)

- Organizational changes
- Updated terminology

# Notes

- Extensive excludes 1 notes to be reviewed prior to assigning codes

- R00-R09 Symptoms and signs involving the circulatory and respiratory systems
- R10-R19 Symptoms and signs involving the digestive system and abdomen
- R20-R23 Symptoms and signs involving the skin and subcutaneous tissue
- R25-R29 Symptoms and signs involving the nervous and musculoskeletal systems
- R30-R39 Symptoms and signs involving the urinary system
- R40-R46 Symptoms and signs involving cognition, perception, emotional state and behavior
- R47-R49 Symptoms and signs involving speech and voice
- R50-R69 General symptoms and signs
- R70-R79 Abnormal findings on examination of blood, without diagnosis
- R80-R82 Abnormal findings on examination of urine, without diagnosis
- R83-R89 Abnormal findings on examination of other body fluids, substances and tissues, without diagnosis
- R90-R94 Abnormal findings on diagnostic imaging and in function studies, without diagnosis
- R97 Abnormal tumor markers
- R99 Ill-defined and unknown cause of mortality

# Chapter 19 Injury, poisoning and certain other consequences of external causes (S00-t88)

- Arranged by body region starting with the head and ending with the foot
- Conditions are listed using the following subsections
  - Superficial injury
  - Open wound
  - Fracture
  - Dislocation and sprain
  - Injury of nerves
  - Injury of blood vessels
  - Injury of muscle and tendon
  - Crushing injury
  - Traumatic amputation
  - Other and unspecified injuries

# Poisoning

- Lists Drug, followed by...
  - Poisoning
  - Adverse effects of
  - Underdosing of drugs

# Notes

- ‘code also any associated wound infection’
- ICD-9-CM had a fourth digit
- For complications of surgical and medical care there is a note stating to use additional code (Y62-&82) to identify devices involved and details of circumstances

- S00-S09 Injuries to the head
- S10-S19 Injuries to the neck
- S20-S29 Injuries to the thorax
- S30-S39 Injuries to the abdomen, lower back, lumbar spine, pelvis and external genitals
- S40-S49 Injuries to the shoulder and upper arm
- S50-S59 Injuries to the elbow and forearm
- S60-S69 Injuries to the wrist and hand
- S70-S79 Injuries to the hip and thigh
- S80-S89 Injuries to the knee and lowerleg
- S90-S99 Injuries to the ankle and foot
- T07 Unspecified multiple injuries
- T14 Injury of unspecified body region
- T15-T19 Effects of foreign body entering through natural orifice

# Chapter 20 External causes of morbidity (V01-Y95)

- E codes not in Supplemental section
- Found in Chapter 19 or Chapter 20
- Terminology updates
- New codes to indicate the activity of the injured person at the time the event occurred

# Notes

- Notes indicate which categories require the 7<sup>th</sup> character extension to indicate the episode of care
  - Initial
  - Subsequent
  - Secondary consequence or result (sequelae)

- V00-V09 Pedestrian injured in transport accident
- V10-V19 Pedal cyclist injured in transport accident
- V20-V29 Motorcycle rider injured in transport accident

- V50-V59 Occupant of pick-up truck or van injured in transport accident

- Y83-Y84 Surgical and other medical procedures as the cause of abnormal reaction of the patient, or of later complication, without mention of misadventure at the time of the procedure
- Y90-Y95 Supplementary factors related to causes of morbidity classified elsewhere

# Chapter 21 Factors influencing health status and contact with health services (Z00 – Z99)

- New titles
- Not as specific as ICD-9-CM
  - Z16 represents infection with drug resistant microorganisms
  - ICD-9-cm V09 specified the drug

# Notes

- Z codes represent reasons for encounters
- Z codes are provided for occasions when circumstances other than a disease, injury or external cause classifiable to categories A00 – Y84 are recorded as “diagnoses” or “problems”.

- Z00-Z13 Persons encountering health services for examination and investigation
- Z14-Z15 Genetic carrier and genetic susceptibility to disease
- Z16 Infection with drug resistant microorganisms
- Z17 Estrogen receptor status
- Z20-Z28 Persons with potential health hazards related to communicable diseases
- Z30-Z39 Persons encountering health services in circumstances related to reproduction
- Z40-Z53 Persons encountering health services for specific procedures and health care
- Z55-Z65 Persons with potential health hazards related to socioeconomic and psychosocial circumstances
- Z66 Do not resuscitate [DNR] status
- Z67 Blood type
- Z68 Body mass index (BMI)
- Z69-Z76 Persons encountering health services in other circumstances
- Z79-Z99 Persons with potential health hazards related to family and personal history and certain conditions influencing health status
